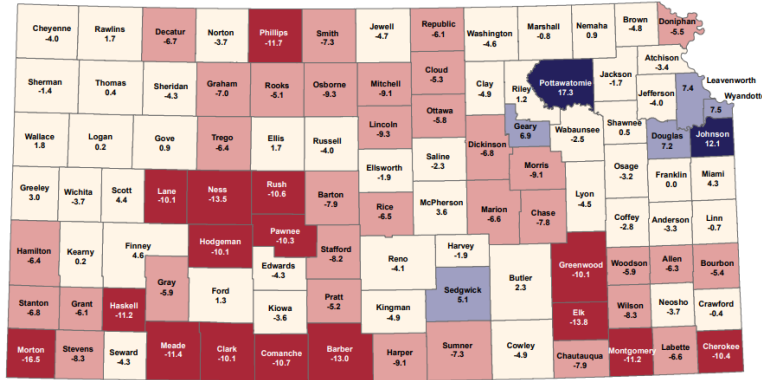


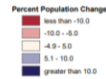

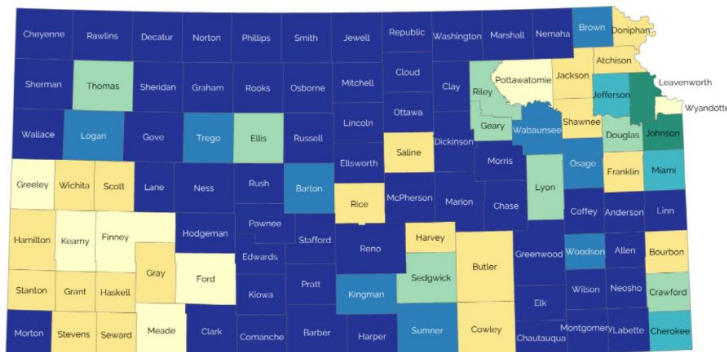

22% Projected Population Decline in Rural and Micropolitan Cities (between 10-50K) by 2064.

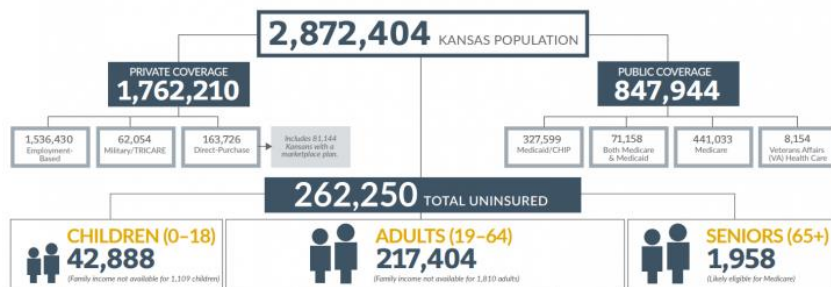
0.4% Annual projected average growth in Kansas for the next 50 years.

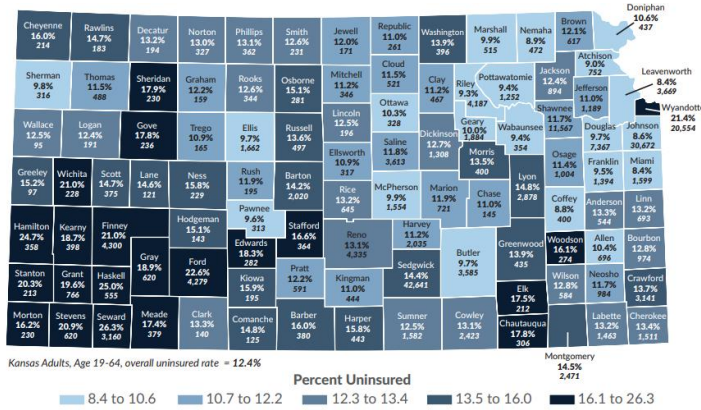
Health Insurance in Kansas 2019

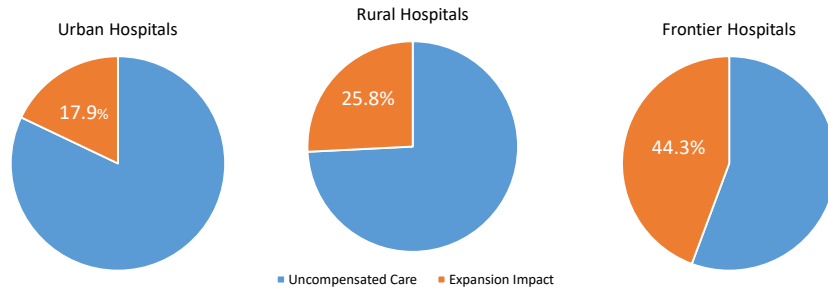
The Number of Uninsured Patients Continues to Grow in Rural Areas
